Scope of Services	Diagnosis, advice and treatment of employees with non-work-related illnesses and injuries, including:  General health surveillance for common chronic conditions, such as high blood pressure and diabetes, or those periodically absent as a result of sickness or injury;  Medication management (stock control, dispensing, etc.);  Family planning, excluding pap smears. This will be costed for and billed by the doctor for the employee to claim through their relevant medical scheme where applicable (outside Kaelo's scope of practice). Family planning products are available at no cost to Client subject to the availability from the State ('Department of Health'), failing which Kaelo would need to bill Client for the required Family Planning products on a fee-for-service basis, approval of which will be obtained from Client prior to placing an order;  Monthly Health education as per Health awareness calendar;  Appropriate referral mechanisms for specialist assessment and care;  Contact management with off-site referral routes (specialists, rehabilitation services).  In terms of the Medicines and Related Subs licence is required for the person authorised clinic. Therefore, the phasing-in of services, healthcare, is recommended to allow time to Department of Health for dispensing medic	Occupational Health may be described as a unique discipline, because it requires an interdisciplinary team effort. Related disciplines such as occupational medicine, nursing, industrial hygiene, safety and management, must all liaise to develop a total healthcare programme. This project will require the coordination of Kaelo as well as the SHERQ and Human Resources departments of Client. The occupational medical practitioner should review the Health Risk Assessment risk assessments every two years, or: whenever there are any significant changes to workplace processes or design.
